LONDON BOROUGH OF BARNET

SOLID FUEL

1967

BYELAWS

relating to the sale of Solid Fuel made by the Council of the London Borough of Barnet pursuant to paragraph 5 of Schedule 6 of the Weights and Measures Act, 1963.

PRICE OF SOLID FUEL TO BE DISPLAYED ON PREMISES

1. (1) Any person being the owner or occupier of, or being in charge of, premises on or from which solid fuel available for the purchase in a quantity of two hundred-weights or less is sold or kept or exposed for sale shall display and keep displayed in some conspicuous place on the premises a notice on which shall be clearly and legibly marked in figures of at least the size hereinafter specified the price at which the fuel is kept or exposed for sale.

(2) The figures in which the said price is stated shall, in the case of such premises being a vehicle, be not less than three inches in height and of proportionate breadth, and in any other case, one and three eighths inches in height and half an inch in breadth.

(3) No person shall alter, deface or remove any such notice except for the purpose of showing a change in price and any alteration for that purpose shall not be made except, in the case of a notice on a vehicle, at the place of the loading of that vehicle or at the office of the owner of the fuel, or in any other case, at the commencement of business at the premises upon any day upon which the premises are open for the sale of fuel.

SOLID FUEL NOT TO BE SOLD AT MORE THAN MARKED PRICE

2. No person being the owner or occupier or in charge of premises on or from which solid fuel available for purchase in a quantity of two hundred-weights or less is sold or kept or exposed for sale on which premises is displayed a notice as specified in the foregoing Byelaw shall on a sale of any such fuel charge to the purchaser any price greater than that marked on the said notice upon the day of sale.

PENALTY FOR OFFENCES AGAINST BYELAWS

3. Every person who shall contravene or fail to observe any one or any part of any one of the foregoing Byelaws shall be liable to a penalty not exceeding £20 for each offence.

SHORT TITLE

4. These Byelaws may be cited as the London Borough of Barnet Sale of Solid Fuel Byelaws, 1967.

INTERPRETATION

"premises" includes any place and any stall, vehicle, ship or aircraft.

"solid fuel" is defined as coal, coke and any solid fuel derived from coal or of which coal or coke is a constituent.
