- Annual Summer Celebration and achievements event – a fun day for everyone
- Holiday activities. Past events have included theatre trips, tea with the mayor and celebrating Black History Month.
- Discussions about things that are important to you.
- Giving your views and ideas about how to make services better and influence decision makers to make changes. For example, in November 2022 BOP opened our family services staff conference and led an exercise for 400 professionals.
