ORDER 2020**

The above order was made on 29th October 2020. The effect of the order will be to extinguish the public footpath described below and as shown striped black and white on the attached map with reference 23624002-STR-HGN-100-DR-D-10007 ("the Map").

The Order will enable the regeneration at Brent Cross, Cricklewood to be carried out in accordance with planning permissions granted under Part III of the Act by the Council under reference number F/04687/13 and will be for no other purpose.

If no such representations or objections are duly made, or if any so made are withdrawn, the Council may itself confirm the order as an unopposed order. If the order is sent to the Secretary of State for the Environment for confirmation any representations or objections which have not been withdrawn will be sent with the order.
